In addition to the species listed overleaf, records of species or subspecies not yet seen in Switzerland in the wild must be submitted to the Swiss Rarities Committee with a full description, as well as first breeding records. Similarly, hybrids in which one of the parents is a species considered by the SRC all year in all parts of the country must also be submitted to the SRC.

## SRC seasonal criteria for submission

The SRC also examines reports of commoner species seen at unusual dates or locations. The periods during which submission is required have been fixed for each species (except resident species) and are listed below. Generally speaking, the particular species has never, or only very rarely, been observed during the given period. A few species (Greater Scaup, Whiskered Tern and White-winged Tern) are not unusual during the given period but their identification is not straightforward.
